# BOATING RULES

---

- \_\_\_\_\_ The boating season will begin on May 1, 2024 and will end on October 1, 2024. The Glenview Park District reserves the right to reduce the length of the boating season and/or the number of hours per day that Boating Activities will be permitted for emergency safety reasons, environmental conditions, or wildlife concerns. No boating is allowed on July 4<sup>th</sup> and when the red flag is posted.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Prior to boating on Lake Glenview a Glenview Park District permit must be purchased at Park Center, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Park District's permit application.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Boating on Lake Glenview is unsupervised.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Boating on Lake Glenview is done at your own risk.
- \_\_\_\_\_ A red flag posted at the entry point indicates unsafe conditions. For your safety, no boating is allowed on these days.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Immediately upon their first awareness of an approaching thunderstorm or high wind conditions (whether or not the lightning detection system has been activated and/or a red flag posted), boaters shall return to the designated entry/exit point, remove boats, and refrain from further usage unless and until they are able to confirm that the weather event has passed from the area.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Only kayaks, canoes and rowboats, are allowed on Lake Glenview (no motorized water craft, no sailboats and no paddle boards).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Motorized vehicles will not be allowed past the parking lots, handcarts may be used to transport any boats from parking lots to boat launch area.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Boating is allowed from sunrise to sunset (no boating after dark).
- \_\_\_\_\_ Fishing is allowed from boats, but is subject to all Village of Glenview ordinances, rules, and regulations concerning fishing on Lake Glenview.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older. The adult must be in a kayak, canoe, or rowboat that is on the water at all times that the child under 13 is on the water in a kayak, canoe, or rowboat.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Life jackets must be worn at all times.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Swimming and ice skating are not allowed in Lake Glenview.
- \_\_\_\_\_ The islands in Lake Glenview are off limits as well as areas marked by buoys.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Alcohol is not allowed in Gallery Park or in boats on Lake Glenview.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Dogs are not allowed on boats in Lake Glenview.
- \_\_\_\_\_ No standing, changing seats, horseplay, or intentional tipping during operation of the boat, even for training purposes.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hands and feet must remain in the boat at all times.
- \_\_\_\_\_ No splashing or colliding with other boats.
- \_\_\_\_\_ All boats and accessories entering Lake Glenview must be clean and dry to prevent the introduction of invasive species.
- \_\_\_\_\_ There is only one entry/exit point for boats, which is designated on posted signage. Boats may not be launched from or landed elsewhere along the shoreline.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Failure by boaters to comply with these self-supervised Rules may result in loss of boating privileges and or revocation of boating permit.
