Purpose: To establish guidelines governing eligibility for participation in Glenview Park District programs.

Equal Access to Facilities and Programs

No participant shall, on the basis of race, sex, creed, age (excepting those 17 and under, for whom special rules and policies may apply), national origin, disability, or sexual orientation, be denied equal access to programs, activities, services or benefits, or be limited in the exercise of any right, privilege, advantage or opportunity.

Program Eligibility Requirements

Participation in activities sponsored by the District shall be open to all residents of the District in line with various age, sex or member limit criteria as may be established for particular programs. Nonresidents of the District may also register for District programs based upon availability and payment of the designated fee.

Americans with Disabilities Act

The Glenview Park District shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) which prohibits discrimination in the provision of services, programs or facilities to individuals with disabilities. The District shall strive to meet the needs of these individuals through facility accessibility, program inclusion and communication devices.

Denial of Participation

All participation in District activities shall be considered a privilege which may be denied if the participant fails to abide by the Glenview Park District Code of Conduct for Employees and Participants as established in Park District Policy 7.15 or if the participant's presence is to the detriment of the other participants in the program.
