## ICE, CAMERA, ACTION!

### Ice Show 2026 Participation Criteria & Important Details

*Please carefully review the following eligibility requirements for the 2026 Ice Show:*

#### Group Performances

- All participants must be registered for Fall 2025 or our current 2025-26 winter session to participate

#### Solo Performances

- Skaters must have a clean Axel at the time of registration.
  - *Exception: Skaters who performed a solo last year without an Axel will remain eligible to perform a solo this year.*
- Skaters must have passed Gold (Freestyle 6) by the time of registration.
- Skaters not enrolled in group lessons must submit a coach's recommendation to confirming a clean Axel. Submissions should be sent to [gicicfrontdesk@glenviewparks.org](mailto:gicicfrontdesk@glenviewparks.org).
- Enrolled in at least ONE GPD Skating Academy Learn-to-Skate Session (Gold Free Skate 5 or higher) since October 1, 2025 and/or skate regularly 2 hours per week at GCIC beginning November 23rd, 2025- April 2026.

#### Duets & Trios

- Skaters may choose their partners.
- All participating skaters must be at Silver level (Free Skate 3/4) or have passed Pre-preliminary, at the time of registration.
- Each participating skater must be registered.

**Solos, Duets, or Trios must register for the Solo Opening Production number and their corresponding group number. Skaters who are not currently enrolled in group lessons may register for the Production number in lieu of their level-specific group number.**

***Eligible skaters may participate in either a Solo, Duet, or Trio performance – but may only choose one. Skaters cannot register for more than one of these performance types.***

#### Small Group Numbers (Character or Themed Number)

*Small group numbers are a great way to participate in a themed or character-style performance with 4–6 skaters. These mini groups will bring a fun performance style to the show. With the director's guidance on costumes and the choreographer's input, skaters will work together with the choreographer to decide on costumes, with final approval from the director.*

- Open to Bronze & Above
- Skaters participating in a regular group number are eligible to be in a small group number as well. However, skaters performing a solo, duet, or trio in the show are not eligible to participate in a small group number.

#### Costume Measurements

- To complete registration, all skaters must have costume measurements submitted. Skaters can be measured by GCIC staff or at the front desk with a parent or guardian present. Alternatively, parents may choose to measure their skaters at home and submit the measurements via email to [gicicfrontdesk@glenviewparks.org](mailto:gicicfrontdesk@glenviewparks.org).

***Please note: Soloists, duets, & trios are responsible for providing their own costume for their assigned program.***
