# BOATING RULES

Boating season is May 1 – October 1, sunrise to sunset. No boating after dark.

Boating on Lake Glenview is unsupervised and at your own risk.

The Glenview Park District reserves the right to reduce the length of the boating season and/or the number of hours per day boating activities are permitted for emergency/safety reasons, environmental conditions or wildlife concerns.

There is only one entry/exit point for boats, which is designated on posted signage. Boats may not be launched from or landed elsewhere along the shoreline. Boating Maps available online or by request.

Follow all boating signage including “ No Boating” signs posted after the close of the season.

Prior to boating on Lake Glenview, a Glenview Park District permit must be purchased at Park Center, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Park District’s permit application.

Immediately upon their first awareness of an approaching thunderstorm, high winds (no boating with winds over 20 mph) or poor visibility (whether or not the lightning detection system has been activated), boaters shall return to the designated entry/exit point, remove boats and refrain from further usage, unless and until, they are able to confirm the weather event has passed from the area.

Kayaks, canoes and rowboats are allowed on Lake Glenview only (no motorized or inflatable watercraft, sailboats, paddle boards, or other floatation devices).

Motorized vehicles are not allowed past the parking lots. Handcarts may be used to transport any boats from parking lots to boat launch area.

Fishing is allowed from boats, and is subject to all Village of Glenview ordinances, rules and regulations concerning fishing on Lake Glenview.

Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult, 18 years of age or older. The adult must be in a kayak, canoe or rowboat which must be on the water at all times the child, under 13, is on the water in a kayak, canoe or rowboat.

Life jackets must be worn at all times.

Islands in Lake Glenview are off limits as well as areas marked by buoys.

No standing, changing seats, horseplay or intentional tipping during operation of the boat, even for training purposes.

Hands and feet must remain in the boat at all times.

No splashing or colliding with other boats.

All boats and accessories entering Lake Glenview must be clean and dry to prevent the introduction of invasive species.

Failure by boaters to comply with these self-supervised rules, may result in loss of boating privileges or revocation of boating permit.

Swimming, ice skating, alcohol and dogs are not allowed at Lake Glenview.
