### Required:

- Completed Community Bark West Veterinarian Verification Form (*within one month*)
- IF VET FORM IS OLDER THAN ONE MONTH** - Itemized invoice from veterinarian with required vaccinations AND 6-month fecal exam with expiration dates.
- NEW MEMBERS WITH GLENVIEW ADDRESS or ADDRESS CHANGE ONLY** – Proof of residency: *gas, electric or water bill, current tax bill, purchase agreement or lease. Driver's license will not be accepted.*

Applicants will be contacted if application is incomplete; incomplete applications cannot be processed.

# Glenview Park District Liability Waiver

## Important Information

You are solely responsible for supervising your dog(s) and determining whether or not this is an appropriate activity in which to participate. You must understand that you are participating in this activity at your own risk (and risk of your dog(s)). You are solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog(s) are physically (or temperamentally) fit and/or adequately skilled to use the dog park. The risk of contagion exists for both you and your dog(s). It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog(s) is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before using the dog park.

## Warning of Risk

Dog activities are intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog(s) and its owner. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury and contagion, including death to either the dog(s) or its owner. Dogs are pack animals and when "off leash", even the best-trained dogs will act instinctively. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to another patron or dog(s). Other risks include, but are not limited to the inexperience, negligence or irresponsibility of a dog owner; the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog(s) due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting and biting. Other risks include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, contagious diseases, acts of God, inclement weather, slipping, falling, premises defects, failure in instruction and or supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to dog and outdoor activities. Should you attempt to break up a fight between dogs, you may be attacked and severely mauled by the other dog(s) or even attacked by the other patron.

In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Glenview Park District to guarantee absolute safety.

## Waiver and Release of All Claims and Indemnification Agreement

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in consideration for permission to use this facility, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and WAIVING and RELEASING all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your dog(s) might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with presence upon and use of the dog park.

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury and sickness for the dog(s) and their humans (owners/handlers) in association with participating in dog activities, and I voluntarily agree to abide by all applicable rules and assume the full risk of any injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity, there I might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of the dog park. I do hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge the Glenview Park District including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees from any and all claims for injuries, damages or loss that I may have or which may accrue to me and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with this use of this facility or surrounding area.

I further agree to INDEMNIFY and hold harmless and defend the Glenview Park District from and against any and all losses, injuries, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions, and expenses (including attorney fees), on account of personal injuries or death to any person or dog(s), or damages to property occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my and my dog's use of this facility or surrounding area. I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk and waiver and release of all claims.

# COMMUNITY BARK WEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

Community Bark West rules are listed below. These are posted at the dog park entrance as well as on our website at [glenviewparks.org](http://glenviewparks.org). Park rules must be adhered to at all times while using the dog park. Infraction of these rules may result in temporary or permanent loss of park privileges.

- Users of this facility do so at their own risk. The Glenview Park District is not responsible for any injury or damage caused by any dog in the off-leash area.
- In case of emergency (dog bit or unsafe behavior) immediately call 911 for assistance. All other issues call 847-724-5670.
- All users will abide by the Glenview Park District "Code of Conduct". See Glenview Park District Policies/Behavior at [glenviewparks.org](http://glenviewparks.org)
- Dogs must be healthy, fully immunized, de-wormed and must display current ID tags on their collar.
- A handler age 16 or older must be present at all times and is solely responsible for the actions of their dog(s).
- Cooperation between dog owners is expected including keeping order and enforcing dog park rules and Park District ordinances.
- Dog Park will be inspected by Glenview Park District employees and the Glenview Police.
- Dog must be leashed prior to entering and leaving the park. Owners must carry a leash for each dog at all times.
- Collars must be worn at all times. No pincher or spiked collars allowed.
- Keep your dogs in sight and never leave dogs in the park unattended.
- No aggressive dogs allowed. Dogs with a known history of, or who exhibit aggressive or dangerous behavior are prohibited. Immediately leash your dog and leave the park if aggressive behavior is observed.
- Maximum number of dogs per adult is two. Both dogs must remain in the same un area with their owner. Large dogs, 26 lbs and above, are not allowed in the small run area.
- Children under 12 years of age are not allowed in the dog park. Children 12-15 years of age must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Ask the owner's permission before approaching their dog.
- Dogs in heat and puppies under 6 months of age are not permitted in the park.
- Immediately clean up and dispose of feces left by your dog.
- Fill any holes your dog may dig.
- Excessive barking is prohibited. Dogs barking excessively must be removed.
- No food of any kind, including dog chews and/or rawhides, are allowed within the fenced area.
- No littering. Place all trash in receptacles.
- No bikes allowed in the dog park.
- Members will have their pass revoked if caught allowing non-members into the park. Climbing on or over the fence is not permitted.
- Keep your dog away from the gate while other dogs are entering or exiting the park.
- Current Cook County rabies tab must be worn on collar or harness at all times when away from your own property.
- Glenview Park District staff has the authority to remove a dog owner from the park at any time.
- The Glenview Park District is not responsible for any damaged, lost or stolen property.
- Glenview Park District staff has the authority to close the site for maintenance, weather related problems and special events without prior notice.
- Hours of operation are 6am-10pm.
