ORDINANCE NO. 2026-10

**Annual Combined Budget & Appropriation Ordinance for the fiscal year
beginning May 1, 2026 and ending April 30, 2027.**

BE IT ORDAINED By the Board of Park Commissioners of the Glenview Park District,
Cook County, Illinois.

SECTION 1. This Ordinance is hereby termed the Annual Combined Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for the Glenview Park District, Cook County, Illinois, as follows,

SECTION 2. That the following sums and amounts are the estimated current revenue and cash on hand at the beginning and ending of the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2026, and ending April 30, 2027, and are part of the Annual Budget.

An estimate of cash on hand May 1, 2026	89,015,947.98
An estimate of cash expected to be received during the fiscal year from all sources	52,232,304.60
An estimate of the expenditures contemplated for the fiscal year is	(52,213,308.82)
An estimate of the cash expected to be on hand April 30, 2027	89,034,943.76
An estimate of the amount of taxes to be received during the year	27,857,626.00

SECTION 3. That the following sums and amounts under the column entitled "Budget" is the annual budget for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2026 and ending April 30, 2027 for all purposes of the Glenview Park District, Cook County, Illinois. That the following sums and amounts under the column entitled "Appropriations" or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, be and they are hereby appropriated for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2026 and ending April 30, 2027 for all purposes of the Glenview Park District, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 4. That any unexpended balance of any items of any appropriation made may be expended in making up any insufficiency in any other item in the same general purpose of any like appropriation made by this ordinance.

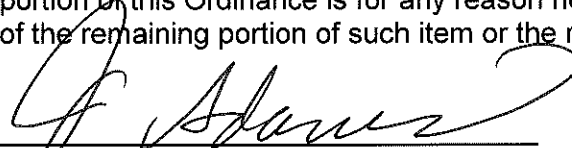
SECTION 5. All unexpended balances of the appropriation for the fiscal year ending the 30th day of April, 2026 and prior years to the extent not otherwise reappropriated for other purposes herein are hereby specifically reappropriated for the same general purposes for which they were originally made and may be expended in making up any insufficiency of any other items provided in this appropriation ordinance, pursuant to law.

All receipts and revenues not specifically appropriated, and all unexpended balances in unrestricted funds from preceding fiscal years not required for the purpose for which they were appropriated and levied shall constitute the general fund and shall be placed to the credit of such fund.

This ordinance is not intended or required to be in support of or in relation to any tax levy made by the Park District during the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2026 and ending April 30, 2027 or any other fiscal year.

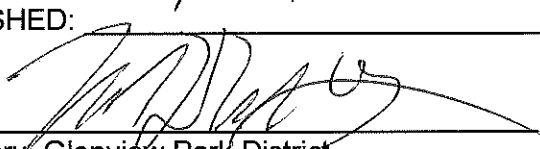
SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law. A certified copy of the Ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk of Cook County, Illinois, together with the certificate of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the Park District certifying revenues by source anticipated to be received by the Park District, within thirty (30) days after its passage and approval, as provided by law.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby modified or repealed to the extent of each conflict. If any item or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of such item or the remainder of this Ordinance.
