

**SUMMARY OF FILING PROCEDURE
FOR GLENVIEW PARK DISTRICT CANDIDATES
APRIL 6, 2027 CONSOLIDATED ELECTION**

PETITIONS AVAILABLE:	Nominating Petitions are available at the Park District's offices beginning August 25, 2026 during regular office hours (Monday- Friday 9:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m.) The first day to circulate nominating petitions is August 25, 2026.
NUMBER OF VACANCIES:	Three (3) Park Commissioners are to be elected each for six-year (6) terms. (NOTE: The aforementioned are unpaid elected positions and may only be filled by persons who are registered voters and who have lived within the Park District boundaries for one (1) year prior to April 6, 2027.)
NUMBER OF SIGNATURES:	Based on the total ballots cast in the last Park District Commissioner election, at least 148 signatures of qualified voters, residing within the Park District boundaries are required on each candidate's Petition.
FIRST DAY TO FILE:	First day to file Petitions is Monday, November 16, 2026 beginning at 9:00 a.m. Date and time of filing generally determine ballot position; however, petitions deemed simultaneously filed are assigned ballot position by lottery.
LAST DAY TO FILE:	Last day to file Petitions is Monday, November 23, 2026 no later than 5:00 p.m. Date and time of filing generally determine ballot position; however, petitions deemed simultaneously filed are assigned ballot position by lottery.
ETHICS STATEMENT:	Petitions must be accompanied by a Statement of Candidacy and receipt showing filing of an ethics statement (Statement of Economic Interests) with the County Clerk. The Statement of Economic Interests must be filed with the County Clerk (during the calendar year in which the nominating petitions are filed). Please note that although the ethics statement receipt does not necessarily have to be filed when candidates (including incumbent Commissioner candidates) file their Petitions, it is recommended they do so; otherwise the receipt must be filed with the Park District Secretary's office no later than the last day to file on Monday, November 23, 2026 by 5:00 p.m.
WHERE TO FILE:	Petitions must be filed with the Park District Secretary's designee at the Glenview Park District offices, 1930 Prairie Street, Glenview, IL 60025. All Petitions filed by persons waiting in line at the office as of 9:00 a.m. on the first day for filing, as well as Petitions received in the first mail delivery that first day of filing, are deemed simultaneously filed as of 9:00 a.m. If two or more petitions are filed within the last hour of the filing deadline (between 4:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the last filing day) they shall also be deemed filed simultaneously. Whenever two or more Petitions are simultaneously filed, the election official shall break ties and determine the order of filing by means of a lottery. The Park District Secretary or designee conducts a lottery within nine (9) days following the last day of Petition filing to determine ballot position. Candidates involved in a lottery will be notified and may be present at the lottery. Seven days written notice of the time and place of conducting the lottery will be given to the Chair of each political party and to each organization of citizens within the election jurisdiction which was entitled to have poll watchers present on the day of next preceding election. The lottery (if necessary) for the April 6, 2027 election will be held Tuesday, December 1, 2026 at 10:00 a.m. at the 1930 Prairie Street Administrative Offices.
